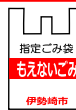

Dirty cans, oil cans, square's 1.8 liters cans (for food), oil cans (for vehicles), etc. should be put out as non-burnable garbage |

Wrap sharp objects in paper before putting them out. Soak flammable items in water before disposing them Remove soil from plants and trees and allow them to dry. |

Dispose of solid vegetable oil as burnable garbage. Animal cooking oil should be solidified with a coagulant and disposed of as burnable garbage. For mineral oil (engine oil, kerosene, etc.), consult your dealer. |

Dispose of cassette cylinders and spray cans without making holes. If the contents cannot be used up and cannot be emptied, consult a cleaning facility. |
