- 4 Until 8:30 am!!
- 5 At the designated garbage collection point in the town!

Items to be disposed at garbage station	<b>Pet bottles</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For beverages</li> <li>For liquor</li> <li>For seasonings etc.</li> </ul> <p>1 Label and cap Rinse inside</p> <p>2 Collect caps in a plastic bag and put them in the same bag used to collect plastic (pet) bottles.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put it in a designated bag for non-burnable garbage (including plastic bags with caps)</li> <li>Labels are put out as burnable garbage</li> <li>If there is a plastic mark, put it out as burnable garbage</li> </ul>
	<b>Bottles</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beverage bottles: Nutrition drinks, wine, etc.</li> <li>Food bottles: Jams, instant coffee etc.</li> <li>Regular medicine bottles</li> <li>Cosmetic bottles</li> </ul> <p>Clean up</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the lid is difficult to separate, leave it on</li> <li>If the label sticker cannot be removed, leave it on</li> <li>Plastic lids should be disposed in burnable garbage</li> <li>Metal lids are put out as non-burnable garbage</li> <li>Return beer bottles to the retailer if possible</li> </ul>
	<b>Cans</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beverage cans: Juices, alcoholic beverages, tea, coffee etc.</li> <li>Canned food</li> <li>Confectionery cans</li> <li>Tea canister</li> <li>Milk cans</li> </ul> <p>Crush and dispose</p> <p>Clean up</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dispose of cassette cylinders and spray cans as dangerous goods</li> <li>Large cans (e.g. milk cans) must be crushed before disposal</li> <li>Please cooperate with the collection of cans, place them in the town's recycling location</li> <li>Dirty cans, oil cans, square's 1.8 liters cans, oil cans (for vehicles), etc. should be put out as non-burnable garbage</li> </ul>
	<b>Non burnable garbage</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Metal products: Cooking utensils</li> <li>Home appliances: Printers, microwaves</li> <li>Cutlery: Wrap dangerous things in paper and write "dangerous" in red.</li> <li>Dirty bottles and cans</li> <li>Square's 1.8 liters cans</li> <li>Pottery and porcelain</li> <li>Made of glass</li> <li>Light bulbs</li> <li>Bath mat</li> <li>Tyres chains (Metal)</li> <li>Umbrellas</li> <li>Iron arrays (Dumbbells) etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dispose of cassette cylinders and spray cans as dangerous goods</li> <li>Dangerous items, such as knives and broken items, should be wrapped in paper and marked "dangerous" in red</li> <li>Items that do not fit in the designated rubbish bags should be put out as oversize waste</li> </ul>
	<b>Burnable garbage</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>kitchen waste: Drain well</li> <li>Non-recyclable clothing: Soiled or torn clothing, Boots</li> <li>Pruned tree: Do not put pruned wood in the designated garbage bag</li> <li>Paper with food or oil stains or odors</li> <li>Sanitary paper and special processed paper</li> <li>Plants and trees</li> <li>Cooking oil of animal origin (solidified with coagulant)</li> <li>Pet litter etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Drain food waste thoroughly before disposing of it</li> <li>Wrap sharp objects in paper before putting them out</li> <li>Soak flammable items in water before disposing them</li> <li>Pruned trees should be no longer than 70cm in length, no thicker than 15cm, and no larger than 30cm in diameter, tied in two places with string</li> </ul>
Items to be disposed at recyclable collection place.	<b>Oversized waste</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Household goods and furniture: Chests of drawers, Tables</li> <li>Futon: Mattresses</li> <li>Electrical, oil, gas appliances: Stoves, Fan</li> <li>Items that do not fit in designated garbage bags: Wardrobe, Cupboard, Desk, Chair, Electric Kotatsu, Bicycle, Stroller, Golf equipment, Tyres / Wheels etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please take out your garbage within the time designated by the administrative district</li> <li>Remove batteries from the main unit</li> <li>Use up all the fuel and empty it</li> </ul>
	<b>Used paper</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Used paper: Newspaper / leaflet, Magazine, Cardboard, Paper pack</li> <li>Clothes: T-shirt, Dress, Suit, Towels, Blanket, Sheets, Curtain, Hat, Plush toys, Bag etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Used paper: Newspapers and leaflets should be tied together or placed in a paper bag</li> <li>Magazines tied up with string</li> <li>Cardboard should be crushed and then tied with string</li> <li>Paper cartons: 1 Wash inside 2 Open 3 Dry 4 Tie with string</li> <li>Collect miscellaneous items in a paper bag and fasten them in two places with gum tape, etc</li> </ul>
	<b>Clothes</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clothes: 1 Wash and dry thoroughly 2 Fold up and place in a designated bag for cans 3 Tie the designated bag tightly</li> <li>*If it is raining on the collection day, or rain is forecast, dispose of it the following month, or in a resource storage facility.</li> </ul>
	<b>Foam tray</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Checkpoint: Items that have a plastic mark, Not colored (white), Easy to break, Toothpicks can easily stab</li> </ul> <p>Clean up</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put out in a net bag that is installed at a resource collection site in the town block</li> <li>Remove labels and price stickers as much as possible</li> <li>If it is too dirty to clean, it cannot be recycled and should be disposed of in burnable garbage</li> </ul>
	<b>Waste cooking oil</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vegetable oil in liquid state: Salad oil, Rapeseed oil, Sesame oil etc.</li> <li>1 Remove any solids from the oil</li> <li>2 Pour in to a plastic bottle container</li> <li>3 Close the cap tightly</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Place it in containers at the town's resource collection points</li> <li>Even expired or unopened products can be disposed of</li> <li>Dispose of solid vegetable oil as burnable garbage</li> <li>Animal cooking oil should be solidified with a coagulant and disposed of as burnable garbage</li> <li>For mineral oil (engine oil, kerosene, etc.), consult your dealer</li> </ul>
	<b>Hazardous materials</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cassette cylinders, Spray cans: Make sure it is done outdoors, away from fire and in a well-ventilated area. Use up or dispose of the contents completely.</li> <li>Disposable lighter, Oil / Gas Lighter: Use up the contents</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put each item in a container at a resource collection point in the town</li> <li>*Do not put out trash that cannot be collected</li> <li>Dispose of cassette cylinders and spray cans without making holes</li> <li>If the contents cannot be used up and cannot be emptied, consult a cleaning facility</li> </ul>
	<b>Harmful substances</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fluorescent lights (tubes or lamps)</li> <li>Dry cell batteries</li> <li>Lithium primary battery (with symbols of lithium, CR, BR, ER)</li> <li>Coin battery (with CR and BR symbols)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dispose of only the unit in the containers at the collection points in the town</li> <li>*Do not put out trash that cannot be collected</li> <li>Take boxes and bags and sort them properly</li> <li>Button battery (with SR, PR, LR symbols) ▶ Use of cooperating shops of the battery industry association</li> <li>Small rechargeable battery ▶ Dispose of it in special collection boxes in some public facilities</li> </ul>

Items that cannot be accepted by the city (difficult to dispose of items)

Industrial waste: Auto parts, Oil (machine oil), Gasoline / kerosene, Drums, Lumber, timbers, logs, Construction waste etc.

Agricultural waste: Agricultural waste material, Pesticide, Agricultural equipment, Corrugated board, Vinyl house (seat / pipe) etc.

Items difficult to carry: Piano, Storage room etc.

Medical waste: Injection needle, Syringe etc.

Others: Button battery, Soil / mud / gravel etc.

Items to be brought into the cleaning facility (charged)

- Large primary garbage (moving, general cleaning)
- Mattress, sofa (with spring or magnet)
- Tatami mats (up to 16 sheets)
- Frame, Massage chair
- Panel heater etc.

It is the responsibility of the business owner to dispose of it properly in accordance with the law!
